The Project Development Facility (PDF)-B aims to develop a full size project proposal. The objectives of the project are to reverse the process of land degradation, improve ecosystem integrity services and functions, and improve human livelihoods in the target area. This will be achieved through the promotion of integrated and sustainable community-based natural resource management activities such as bamboo regeneration, livestock breed conservation and improvement, soil conservation measures on farmland, and the promotion of alternatives sources of fuelwood (e.g. biogas). Emphasis will be placed also on promoting integrated or holistic solutions, such as the use of biogas slurry and manure for farmland productivity increase. Fodder development and the promotion of Non-Timber Forest Produce may also be considered.
